SPECIAL TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE HONG KONG MARATHON 2025

Notice is hereby given that special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on 8 February 2025 (Saturday) and 9 February 2025 (Sunday) to facilitate the holding of the Hong Kong Marathon 2025:

I. TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS

HONG KONG ISLAND

(A) Road Closures (See Plans 1, 2 and 3)

Depending on the actual finishing time of the race, and complete clearance for safe re-opening of roads to vehicular traffic, the following roads on Hong Kong Island will be closed to all vehicular traffic at the time specified below (except vehicles with closed road permits):

Phase I

From 1.15 am to about 10.30 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound between Wan Chai and Island Eastern Corridor (the closure of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound between Central and Wan Chai as listed in Phase II below will continue to about 1.30 pm).

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Connaught Road West flyover eastbound heading for Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound, Island Eastern Corridor eastbound and Eastern Harbour Crossing will be diverted via Connaught Road West eastbound at-grade, Connaught Road Central eastbound at-grade, Man Kat Street, Connaught Road Central, Gloucester Road, Victoria Park Road, Gordon Road, Electric Road and Java Road.

Phase II

From 1.15 am to about 1.30 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Connaught Road West flyover eastbound between Shing Sai Road and Rumsey Street;
- (ii) Man Po Street;
- (iii) Yiu Sing Street;
- (iv) Lung Wo Road eastbound;
- (v) The slip road from Connaught Road West flyover to Man Po Street;
- (vi) The slip road from Connaught Road West flyover to Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound;
- (vii) The slip road from Man Kat Street to the exit in Wan Chai on Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound;
- (viii) Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound between Central and Wan Chai;
- (ix) Exit in Expo Drive on Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound;

- (x) Expo Drive;
- (xi) Expo Drive Central between west of Expo Drive and east of Expo Drive;
- (xii) Expo Drive East southbound; and
- (xiii) Expo Drive East northbound between Expo Drive and north of cul-de-sac road.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Hill Road flyover northbound will be diverted via Connaught Road West eastbound at-grade;
- (ii) Vehicles on Shing Sai Road eastbound will be diverted via Connaught Road West eastbound;
- (iii) Vehicles on Lung Wo Road will be prohibited from turning onto Yiu Sing Street westbound;
- (iv) Vehicles on Man Yiu Street will be prohibited from turning left onto Lung Wo Road eastbound;
- (v) Vehicles on Man Yiu Street will be prohibited from turning left onto Yiu Sing Street eastbound.

Phase III

From 1.30 am to about 10.30 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Island Eastern Corridor eastbound between Victoria Park Road eastbound and Tung Hei Road slip road; and
- (ii) the slip roads of Hing Fat Street, Man Hong Street and Taikoo Wan Road leading to Island Eastern Corridor eastbound.

Phase IV

From 1.30 am to about 11.30 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Island Eastern Corridor westbound between Tung Hei Road slip road and Victoria Park Road westbound;
- (ii) the slip roads of Nam On Street, Chai Wan Road, Tai Hong Street, Oi Shun Road, Hong On Street, Taikoo Wan Road, King's Road westbound junction with Healthy Street Central, Tong Shui Road and Wharf Road leading to Island Eastern Corridor westbound;
- (iii) the slip roads leading from the exit of Eastern Harbour Crossing to Island Eastern Corridor westbound (except the section up between the exit of Eastern Harbour Crossing and the down ramp slip road leading to Man Hong Street that will be reopened at about 10.30 am);
- (iv) Oi Shun Road westbound between Oi Tak Street and Tai On Street;
- (v) Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound between Island Eastern Corridor and Wan Chai; and
- (vi) The slip road leading from Tsing Fung Street vehicular flyover and Hing Fat Street to Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Victoria Park Road eastbound and Hing Fat Street heading for Island Eastern Corridor eastbound and Eastern Harbour Crossing will be diverted via Gordon Road, Electric Road and Java Road;
- (ii) Vehicles on Java Road and Man Hong Street heading for Island Eastern Corridor eastbound and Eastern Harbour Crossing will be diverted via King's Road;

- (iii) Vehicles on Taikoo Wan Road heading for Island Eastern Corridor eastbound will be diverted via King's Road and Shau Kei Wan Road;
- (iv) Vehicles on Java Road and King's Road eastbound can gain access to Eastern Harbour Crossing via Hong On Street;
- (v) Vehicles on the exit of Eastern Harbour Crossing heading for Island Eastern Corridor eastbound will be diverted via Tai On Street and Shau Kei Wan Road;
- (vi) Vehicles on Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Nam On Lane and Shau Kei Wan Road;
- (vii) Vehicles on Nam On Lane and Nam Hong Street heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Nam On Street westbound, Sun Sing Street and Shau Kei Wan Road;
- (viii) Vehicles on Chai Wan Road heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Shau Kei Wan Road;
- (ix) Vehicles diverted to Shau Kei Wan Road westbound can gain access to Eastern Harbour Crossing via Tai Ning Street, Sai Wan Ho Street and Tai Hong Street;
- (x) Vehicles on Tai Hong Street will only be allowed for gaining access to Eastern Harbour Crossing and Lei King Wan. Vehicles heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Tai Hong Street, Hong Cheung Street, Tai On Street and Shau Kei Wan Road;
- (xi) Vehicles on Oi Shun Road westbound heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Oi Tak Street, Oi Kan Road, Tai On Street and Oi Shun Road;
- (xii) Hong On Street will only be allowed for gaining access to and from Eastern Harbour Crossing. Vehicles heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Hong On Street westbound and King's Road. Vehicles on Hong Yue Street, except those heading for Eastern Harbour Crossing, will be diverted via Hong On Street westbound;
- (xiii) Vehicles on Taikoo Wan Road slip road heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Taikoo Shing Road and King's Road;
- (xiv) Vehicles from the exit of Eastern Harbour Crossing heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Man Hong Street and King's Road (until 4 am);
- (xv) Vehicles on King's Road westbound junction with Healthy Street Central slip road heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via King's Road westbound;
- (xvi) Vehicles on King's Road westbound junction with Tong Shui Road slip road heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via King's Road westbound;
- (xvii) Vehicles on Tong Shui Road heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Java Road, Kam Hong Street and King's Road;
- (xviii) Vehicles on Wharf Road slip road heading for Island Eastern Corridor westbound will be diverted via Wharf Road westbound, North Point Road, Java Road, Tong Shui Road and King's Road; and
- (xix) Vehicles on Tsing Fung Street vehicular flyover and Hing Fat Street northbound heading for the slip road of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound will be diverted via the remaining lanes on Victoria Park Road.

Phase V

From 3 am to about 8.30 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Harbour Road eastbound between Harbour Drive and Tonnochy Road; and
- (ii) Tonnochy Road northbound between Hung Hing Road and Harbour Road.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Tonnochy Road flyover northbound will be diverted via Harbour Road westbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Harbour Road eastbound will be diverted via Fleming Road northbound; and
- (iii) Vehicles leaving from car parks along Harbour Road eastbound will be diverted via Harbour Road westbound.

Phase VI

From 3 am to about 1.30 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Man Kwong Street;
- (ii) Man Fai Street;
- (iii) The slip road between Rumsey Street and Man Kwong Street;
- (iv) Man Yiu Street southbound between Man Kwong Street and Lung Wo Road; and
- (v) Man Yiu Street northbound between Man Po Street and Man Kwong Street.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Chung Kong Road eastbound will be diverted via Connaught Road Central;
- (ii) Vehicles on Connaught Road Central eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Man Kwong Street; and
- (iii) Vehicles on Man Yiu Street northbound will be diverted via Finance Street westbound.

Phase VII

From 3 am to about 2 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Hung Hing Road eastbound between Expo Drive East and Wan Shing Street;
- (ii) Hung Hing Road westbound between Wan Shing Street and Tonnochy Road;
- (iii) Harbour Road eastbound (fast lane) between Harbour Drive and Tonnochy Road;
- (iv) Tonnochy Road northbound (fast lane) between Hung Hing Road and Harbour Road;
- (v) Tonnochy Road southbound between Harbour Road and Gloucester Road;
- (vi) Marsh Road flyover between Hung Hing Road and Lockhart Road;
- (vii) Marsh Road northbound between Hung Hing Road and Gloucester Road;
- (viii) Lockhart Road eastbound between Marsh Road and Percival Street;
- (ix) Percival Street southbound between Lockhart Road and Hennessy Road;
- (x) Percival Street (except the middle lane) between Jaffe Road and Lockhart Road;
- (xi) Canal Road East southbound between Lockhart Road and Jaffe Road;
- (xii) Canal Road West northbound between Lockhart Road and Jaffe Road;
- (xiii) Marsh Road southbound between Lockhart Road and Jaffe Road;
- (xiv) Marsh Road between Hennessy Road and Lockhart Road
- (xv) Hennessy Road eastbound between Percival Street and Yee Wo Street;
- (xvi) Yee Wo Street eastbound;
- (xvii) Sugar Street;
- (xviii) Gloucester Road southbound between Great George Street and Causeway Road (access to the Tai Hang Road flyover southbound is allowed after 10.45am); and
- (xix) Gloucester Road northbound between the U-turn slip road beneath the Tai Hang Road flyover and Great George Street.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Fleming Road northbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Hung Hing Road eastbound and will be diverted via Fleming Road southbound or Lung Wo Road westbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Wan Shing Street northbound will be diverted to turn right onto Hung Hing Road flyover;
- (iii) Vehicles on Marsh Road northbound will be diverted via Gloucester Road service road or turned onto Marsh Road southbound for access to Jaffe Road;
- (iv) Vehicles on Lockhart Road eastbound will be diverted via Marsh Road northbound at grade;
- (v) Vehicles on Jaffe Road eastbound will be diverted via Percival Street northbound;
- (vi) Vehicles on Percival Street southbound will be diverted via Lockhart Road eastbound;
- (vii) Vehicles on Hennessy Road eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Marsh Road;
- (viii) Vehicles on Tin Lok Lane will be prohibited from going straight onto Marsh Road northbound, and will be diverted to turn left or right onto Hennessy Road;
- (ix) Vehicles on Hennessy Road eastbound heading for Causeway Road will be diverted via Percival Street southbound, Leighton Road, Pennington Street and Yee Wo Street eastbound;
- (x) Vehicles on Yee Wo Street eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Sugar Street;
- (xi) Vehicles on Great George Street heading for Gloucester Road southbound will be diverted via Tai Hang Road flyover southbound; and
- (xii) Vehicles on Victoria Park Road flyover southbound will be diverted via Gloucester Road service road (access to the Tai Hang Road flyover southbound is allowed from 10.45 am).

Phase VIII

From 3.45 am to about 9 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Victoria Park Road;
- (ii) Electric Road between Yacht Street and Park Towers;
- (iii) Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Electric Road; and
- (iv) Tsing Fung Street between Hing Fat Street and Electric Road.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Causeway Road eastbound heading for Hing Fat Street will be diverted via King's Road eastbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on King's Road westbound heading for Hing Fat Street will be diverted via Causeway Road westbound;
- (iii) Vehicles on Electric Road southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Yacht Street (except for access to Park Towers);
- (iv) Vehicles leaving the Park Towers car park will be diverted via Electric Road and Yacht Street;
- (v) Vehicles on Electric Road heading for Tsing Fung Street will be diverted via Yacht Street; and
- (vi) Vehicles on Hing Fat Street southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Gordon Road eastbound.

Phase IX

From 4 am to about 10.45 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Parts of the traffic lanes of Victoria Park Road westbound between the down ramp of Island Eastern Corridor westbound and Gloucester Road westbound (except the slow lane leading to Gloucester Road service road and the 2nd slow lane leading to Gloucester Road westbound); and
- (ii) The flyover leading from Gloucester Road northbound to Gloucester Road westbound.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Tsing Fung Street vehicular flyover will be diverted via the remaining lanes of Victoria Park Road westbound; and
- (ii) Vehicles on the Gloucester Road flyover northbound heading for Gloucester Road westbound will be diverted via Gloucester Road service road.

(B) Postponement of Lockhart Road, East Point Road and Great George Street Pedestrian Precincts

The commencement time of the pedestrian precincts on Lockhart Road (between Cannon Street and East Point Road), East Point Road and Great George Street (between East Point Road and Paterson Street) will be postponed to 3 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday) or upon the re-opening of the major roads on Hong Kong Island.

(C) Suspension of Parking Spaces

- (i) 29 parking spaces in Hing Fat Street public car park (metered parking spaces No. 1619 to 1629 and 1641 to 1644) will be suspended from 3 pm to 10 pm on 8 February 2025 (Saturday);
- (ii) All parking spaces in Hing Fat Street public car park (except the parking spaces designated for people with disabilities) will be suspended from 10 pm on 8 February 2025 (Saturday) to 3 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday);
- (iii) The on-street parking spaces at the following locations will be suspended from 12.01 am to 3 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday):
 - (a) Expo Drive East (pick up / drop off areas);
 - (b) Expo Drive (coach parking spaces);
 - (c) Jaffe Road between Percival Street and Cannon Street (parking spaces designated for people with disabilities);
 - (d) Marsh Road between Lockhart Road and Hennessy Road (motorcycle parking spaces);
 - (e) Gloucester Road near Sugar Street (parking spaces designated for people with disabilities);
 - (f) Rumsey Street near Rumsey Street Multi-Storey Car Park;
 - (g) Yiu Sing Street westbound between Lung Wo Road and Man Yiu Street;
 - (h) Man Kwong Street westbound near Central Ferry Pier No. 3 (goods vehicles parking spaces);
 - (i) Man Kwong Street westbound near Central Ferry Pier No. 8 (goods vehicles parking spaces);

- (j) Outside Central Ferry Pier No. 4 and Central Ferry Pier No. 5 (parking spaces designated for people with disabilities);
- (k) Outside Central Ferry Pier No. 6 and Central Ferry Pier No. 7 (motorcycle parking spaces); and
- (l) Wan Shing Street opposite to Wanchai Station Building.

KOWLOON

(A) Road Closures (See Plan 4)

Depending on the actual finishing time of the race, and complete clearance for safe re-opening of roads to vehicular traffic, the following roads in Kowloon will be closed to all vehicular traffic at the time specified below (except vehicles with closed road permits):

Phase I

From 12.45 am to about 1.15 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) West Kowloon Highway southbound between Mei Ching Interchange and the Western Harbour Crossing;
- (ii) The slip road leading from Lin Cheung Road northbound near Civil Aid Service Headquarters to West Kowloon Highway southbound;
- (iii) The slip road leading from Nga Cheung Road elevated road northbound to West Kowloon Highway southbound;
- (iv) The slip road leading from Jordan Road flyover westbound to West Kowloon Highway southbound;
- (v) The slip road leading from Lin Cheung Road southbound near Yau Ma Tei Interchange to West Kowloon Highway southbound; and
- (vi) The slow lane of Lin Cheung Road Lowest Level Underpass northbound between Austin Road West Underpass and Exit of Lin Cheung Road.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Lin Cheung Road northbound will be prohibited from turning onto the slip road leading from Lin Cheung Road northbound near Civil Aid Service Headquarters to West Kowloon Highway southbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Lin Cheung Road southbound will be diverted to the slip road for Tsim Sha Tsui; and
- (iii) Vehicles on Mei Ching Road eastbound will be prohibited from turning onto the slip road leading from Lin Cheung Road southbound to West Kowloon Highway southbound.

Phase II

From 1 am to about 9 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Salisbury Road eastbound between Star Ferry Pier and Canton Road; and
- (ii) Salisbury Road westbound between Star Ferry Pier and Kowloon Park Drive.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Salisbury Road westbound will be diverted onto Kowloon Park Drive northbound.

Phase III

From 1.40 am to about 10 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Nathan Road northbound between Austin Road and Salisbury Road;
- (ii) Nathan Road southbound between Kimberley Road and Middle Road;
- (iii) Kimberley Road westbound between Nathan Road and Carnarvon Road;
- (iv) Granville Road westbound between Nathan Road and Carnarvon Road;
- (v) Cameron Road eastbound between Nathan Road and Cameron Lane;
- (vi) Humphreys Avenue;
- (vii) Carnarvon Road westbound between Nathan Road and Bristol Avenue;
- (viii) Mody Road between Nathan Road and Bristol Avenue;
- (ix) Haiphong Road between Lock Road and Nathan Road;
- (x) Peking Road between Lock Road and Nathan Road;
- (xi) Middle Road between Hankow Road and Nathan Road; and
- (xii) Salisbury Road Underpass westbound.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Nathan Road southbound will be diverted onto Kimberley Road eastbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Salisbury Road will be prohibited from turning onto Nathan Road northbound;
- (iii) Vehicles on Carnarvon Road northbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Granville Road westbound and Kimberley Road westbound;
- (iv) Vehicles on Haiphong Road eastbound will be diverted to Lock Road southbound; and
- (v) Vehicles on Salisbury Road westbound will be prohibited from going onto Salisbury Road Underpass westbound near Chatham Road South.

Phase IV

From 2.30 am to about 10.45 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) The slip road leading from Lai Po Road eastbound to Lin Cheung Road southbound;
- (ii) The slip road leading from Tsing Sha Highway westbound to Lin Cheung Road southbound;
- (iii) Lin Cheung Road southbound between Lai Po Road and Hoi Fai Road;
- (iv) Lin Cheung Road southbound between Tonkin Street West and Yau Ma Tei Interchange; and
- (v) Yen Chow Street West westbound between Sham Mong Road and Lin Cheung Road.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Lai Po Road eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto the slip road leading to Lin Cheung Road southbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Tsing Sha Highway westbound will be diverted to the slip road leading from Lin Cheung Road southbound to Cheung Sha Wan;
- (iii) Vehicles on Tonkin Street West eastbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Lin Cheung Road southbound to Yau Ma Tei;
- (iv) Vehicles on Lin Cheung Road southbound will be diverted to the slip road leading from Lin Cheung Road southbound to Sham Shui Po (near Tonkin Street West);
- (v) Vehicles on Tonkin Street West westbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Lin Cheung Road southbound;

- (vi) Vehicles on Sham Mong Road northbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Yen Chow Street West westbound;
- (vii) Vehicles on Sham Mong Road southbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Yen Chow Street West westbound; and
- (viii) Vehicles on Yen Chow Street West westbound will be prohibited from turning onto slip road leading to Lin Cheung Road southbound.

Phase V

From 3.30 am to about 10.30 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) The whole section of Argyle Street westbound between Nathan Road and Tong Mi Road, except the following road sections, which will be remained for traffic:
 - 1st lane of Argyle Street westbound between Portland Street and Shanghai Street;
 - 1st lane of Argyle Street westbound between Reclamation Street and Tong Mi Road; and
 - 5th lane of Argyle Street westbound between Shanghai Street and Reclamation Street.
- (ii) The whole section of Cherry Street westbound between Tong Mi Road and Lin Cheung Road, except the following road sections, which will be remained for traffic:
 - 1st lane of Cherry Street westbound between Tong Mi Road and Hoi Wang Road; and
 - 3rd and 4th lanes of Cherry Street westbound between Hoi Wang Road and Cherry Street Underpass;
- (iii) Lin Cheung Road southbound between Hoi Fai Road Roundabout and West Kowloon Highway southbound;
- (iv) Hong Lok Street southbound between Argyle Street and Fife Street; and
- (v) Hoi Wang Road northbound between Hoi Ting Road and Cherry Street.

Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Argyle Street westbound will be diverted to turn onto Nathan Road southbound or Nathan Road northbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on 1st lane of Argyle Street westbound will be diverted to turn left onto Shanghai Street southbound;
- (iii) Vehicles on Shanghai Street southbound will be diverted to turn right onto 5th lane of Argyle Street westbound;
- (iv) Vehicles on 1st lane of Argyle Street westbound will be diverted to turn left onto Tong Mi Road southbound;
- (v) Vehicles on Tong Mi Road southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Argyle Street eastbound;
- (vi) Vehicles on Reclamation Street northbound will be diverted to turn left onto the 1st lane of Argyle Street westbound;
- (vii) Vehicles on Tong Mi Road northbound will be diverted to turn left onto Cherry Street westbound;
- (viii) Vehicles on Cherry Street westbound will be diverted to turn left onto Hoi Wang Road southbound;
- (ix) Vehicles on Hoi Ting Road eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Hoi Wang Road northbound;
- (x) Vehicles on Hoi Ting Road westbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Hoi Wang Road northbound;
- (xi) Vehicles on Hoi Wang Road northbound will be diverted to turn left onto Hoi Ting Road westbound;
- (xii) Vehicles on Tai Kok Tsui Road southbound will be prohibited from going straight to Hoi Wang Road southbound;

- (xiii) Vehicles on Cherry Street westbound will be prohibited from turning onto Lin Cheung Road southbound;
- (xiv) Vehicles on Hoi Fai Road westbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Lin Cheung Road southbound;
- (xv) Vehicles on Hoi Fai Road Roundabout will be prohibited from turning onto Lin Cheung Road southbound;
- (xvi) Vehicles on Hong Lok Street southbound will be diverted to turn right onto Fife Street westbound;
- (xvii) Vehicles on Tong Mi Road southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Bute Street eastbound;
- (xviii) Vehicles on Anchor Street eastbound will be diverted to go straight onto Mong Kok Road eastbound; and
- (xix) Vehicles on Oak Street southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Anchor Street eastbound.

Phase VI

From 3.45 am to about 9.15 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday)

- (i) Fast lane of Kowloon Park Drive northbound between Peking Road and Middle Road;

(B) Suspension of Parking Spaces

(C) Temporary Closure of the Western Harbour Crossing (Hong Kong bound tube)

The Hong Kong bound tube of the Western Harbour Crossing will be closed from 12.45 am to about 1.15 pm on 9 February 2025 (Sunday) (depending on the actual finishing time of the race and re-opening of all connecting roads). The Kowloon bound tube will maintain open to normal traffic.

- (v) The slip road leading from Tsing Yi Hong Wan Road to Stonecutters Bridge eastbound;
- (vi) The slip road leading from Container Port Road South to Tsing Sha Highway (Ngong Shuen Chau Viaduct) eastbound;
- (vii) The slip road from Mei Ching Road leading to West Kowloon Highway southbound (except for vehicles leaving the Container Port via Roundabout 6 to Mei Ching Road and Tsing Kwai Highway (New Territories bound));
- (viii) North West Tsing Yi Interchange U-turn Slip Road from Tsing Yi North Coastal Road eastbound to Tsing Yi North Coastal Road westbound; and
- (ix) The slip road from Cheung Tsing Highway southbound to Tsing Yi Road West.

- (ii) In Kowloon, all PLB / GMB stands and stops within the road closure areas in Tsim Sha Tsui, Yau Ma Tei and Mong Kok will be suspended in phases from 1 am on 9 February 2025 (Sunday) until the safe re-opening of roads.

III. ATTENTION AND APPEAL

Appropriate traffic aids will be erected to guide motorists and notices will be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the temporary arrangements.

Vehicular access to and from hotels and car parks within the affected areas will not be allowed during the period of respective phases of road closures. Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements specified above may be towed away by the Police without prior notice.

Members of the public are advised to plan their routes early, use railway services as far as possible and allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay. In case of traffic congestion, motorists should exercise patience and drive with care, and follow the instructions of the Police on site. Public transport commuters are advised to pay attention to the arrangements of route diversion and changes of stop locations.

Members of the public and tourists heading for Hong Kong-Macau Ferry Terminal, Hong Kong Station and Kowloon Station of Airport Express Line, Hong Kong West Kowloon Station of the High Speed Rail, China Ferry Terminal (China Hong Kong City) or Ocean Terminal are advised to plan their journey early to avoid any delay caused by road closures and traffic diversions

Depending on the prevailing circumstances, other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversion, alterations and suspension of public transport services, may be introduced by the Police at short notice. Members of the public are advised to watch out for the latest traffic news on radio and television.
