Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Sha Tin

Notice is hereby given that the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented during the following periods from 23 June 2015 to 30 June 2015 (except 25 and 28 June 2015) daily to facilitate the replacement of gantry signs:

I. From 12.01 am to 5.30 am

The fast lane of Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound between Lek Yuen Estate and Shing Mun Tunnel Road will be closed to all vehicular traffic.

II. From 1.00 am to 5.30 am

(a) Road and Lane Closure

During the above period, the following road and lane sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (i) Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound between Sha Tin Rural Committee Road and Shing Mun Tunnel Road;
- (ii) the slip road leading from Sha Tin Rural Committee Road to Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound;
- (iii) the traffic lanes of Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound near Sha Tin Market:
- (iv) a traffic lane of Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound near Lek Yuen Estate; and
- (v) a traffic lane of the slip road leading from Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound to Sha Tin Rural Committee Road near Lek Yuen Estate.

(b) Banning of Turning Movement

- (i) During the above period, all vehicles will be prohibited from turning left from Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound onto the slip road leading from Sha Tin Rural Committee Road to Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound; and
- (ii) During the above period, all vehicles will be prohibited from turning right from Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound onto the slip road leading from Sha Tin Rural Committee Road to Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound.

(c) <u>Traffic Diversion</u>

- (iii) Vehicles on Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound heading for Tsuen Wan will be diverted via Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Che Kung Miu Road southbound, Mei Tin Road westbound, Tai Wai Road eastbound and Shing Mun Tunnel Road northbound; and
- (iv) Vehicles on Tai Po Road (Sha Tin section) southbound heading for Kowloon will be diverted via Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Lion Rock Tunnel Road westbound, Tai Po Road (Tai Wai section) southbound and Tsing Sha Highway westbound.

(d) <u>Temporary Transport Arrangement</u>

(i) During the above period, LW route no. N42A on its journey to Tung Chung will be diverted via Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Che Kung Miu Road southbound, Mei Tin Road westbound, Tai Wai

- Road eastbound and Shing Mun Tunnel Road northbound before resuming its original routing;
- (ii) During the above period, LW route no. N42 on its journey to Tung Chung will be diverted via Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Lion Rock Tunnel Road westbound and Sha Tin Centre Street northbound before resuming its original routing;
- (iii) During the above period, KMB route nos. N73 on its journey to Sha Tin Central, N271 on its journey to Hung Hom and XHT route no. N170 on its journey to Sha Tin Central will be diverted via Yuen Wo Road westbound, Tam Kon Po Street northbound, Sha Tin Centre Street southbound, Pak Hok Ting Street southbound and Sha Tin Centre Street northbound before resuming its original routing; and
- (iv) During the above period, GMB route no. 482 on its journey to Tsuen Wan will be diverted via Sha Tin Centre Street southbound, Pak Hok Ting Street southbound, Sha Tin Centre Street westbound and Tai Po Road (Tai Wai section) westbound before resuming its original routing.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. Bus companies will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary transport arrangements.
