Service adjustment of Long Win Bus Route (“LWB”)

A47X (Tai Po (Tai Wo) – Airport (Ground Transportation Centre) (“GTC”))

Members of the public are advised that to facilitate residents of Pak Shek Kok and the Hong Kong Science Park to travel between the Airport and Hong Kong Port of Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, the operating hours of the special departures via Pak Shek Kok and Hong Kong Science Park of LWB Route A47X will be extended from 13 October 2024 (Sunday).
