

## **TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE**

### **Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Mid-Autumn Festival 2024**

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in connection with Mid-Autumn Festival 2024:

#### **I. Special Traffic Arrangements**

##### **Hong Kong Island**

##### **(1) Traffic Arrangements for the Fire Dragon Dance in Tai Hang**

###### **A. Road Closure**

(i) The following roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 2.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily from 16 to 18 September 2024:

- (a) Lai Yin Lane;
- (b) Lin Fa Kung Street East;
- (c) Lin Fa Kung Street West;
- (d) Lily Street;
- (e) Wun Sha Street;
- (f) Ormsby Street;
- (g) Brown Street;
- (h) Warren Street;
- (i) Jones Street;
- (j) Lai Yin Street;
- (k) School Street;
- (l) King Street;
- (m) Shepherd Street;
- (n) Sun Chun Street; and
- (o) Second Lane.

(ii) Tung Lo Wan Road between Causeway Road and Moreton Terrace will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 5.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily

from 16 to 18 September 2024.

B. Traffic Diversion

The following traffic diversion will be implemented from 5.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily from 16 to 18 September 2024:

- (i) All vehicles on King's Road westbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Tung Lo Wan Road;
- (ii) All vehicles on Tung Lo Wan Road eastbound must turn left onto Tung Lo Wan Drive; and
- (iii) All vehicles on Tung Lo Wan Drive southbound must turn right onto Moreton Terrace.

C. Suspension of Parking Spaces

All metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces and parking spaces designated for people with disabilities at the above closed roads will be suspended from 12.00 noon to 11.59 pm daily from 16 to 18 September 2024.

D. Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand outside No. 90-96 Tung Lo Wan Road will be suspended from 5.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily from 16 to 18 September 2024.

(2) Traffic Arrangements in Causeway Bay

A. Pedestrian Scheme

The following roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic for implementation of a part-time pedestrian scheme from 4.00 pm to 11.59 pm on 16 September 2024, from 4.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day; and from 12.00 noon to 11.59 pm on 18 September 2024:

- (i) Lockhart Road east of Cannon Street;
- (ii) East Point Road; and
- (iii) Great George Street west of Paterson Street.

## B. Road Closure

- (i) Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, the following roads may be closed to all vehicular traffic from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024, and from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day:
  - (a) Sugar Street;
  - (b) Paterson Street between Kingston Street and Great George Street;
  - (c) Gloucester Road between Victoria Park Road flyover and Causeway Road (except for vehicles on Tai Hang Road flyover heading for Gloucester Road northbound);
  - (d) Kingston Street westbound between Gloucester Road and Paterson Street;
  - (e) Great George Street east of Paterson Street; and
  - (f) Hing Fat Street (intermittently closed, except for franchised buses and green minibuses).
  
- (ii) If necessary, the following roads may be closed to all vehicular traffic:
  - (a) Cleveland Street between Gloucester Road and Kingston Street;
  - (b) Kingston Street eastbound between Paterson Street and Gloucester Road; and
  - (c) Paterson Street between Kingston Street and Gloucester Road.

## C. Traffic Diversion

Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, the following traffic diversion may be implemented from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024, and from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day:

- (i) All vehicles on Victoria Park Road flyover heading for Gloucester Road southbound must turn right onto Gloucester Road westbound;

- (ii) All vehicles on Paterson Street southbound must turn left onto Kingston Street eastbound;
- (iii) All vehicles on Cleveland Street will be prohibited from turning right onto Kingston Street westbound; and
- (iv) All vehicles on Gloucester Road northbound and Tai Hang Road flyover northbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Kingston Street westbound.

D. Suspension of Carparks and Parking Spaces

- (i) All parking spaces (except parking space designated for the people with disabilities) in Hing Fat Street Public Carpark will be suspended from 5.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day, and from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm on 18 September 2024;
- (ii) Access to the carparks on Great George Street will be restricted during the road closure from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024, and from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day; and
- (iii) Parking spaces designated for the people with disabilities on Gloucester Road northbound near Sugar Street will be suspended from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024, and from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day.

E. Suspension of Public Transport Interchange

Tin Hau Station Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day.

F. Suspension of Taxi Stands

Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, taxi stands on Paterson Street near Great George Street and Electric Road near Park Towers may be suspended from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024, and from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day.

G. Suspension of Public Light Bus Stands

Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, public light bus stands on

Sugar Street and Paterson Street will be suspended from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day, and from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024.

#### H. Prohibition Zone for Learner Drivers

All learner drivers will be prohibited from entering the following roads with any vehicles from 7.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 16 and 18 September 2024, and from 7.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 3.00 am of the following day:

- (i) Leighton Road eastbound;
- (ii) Tin Lok Lane;
- (iii) Tung Lo Wan Road;
- (iv) Hing Fat Street;
- (v) Electric Road between Wing Hing Street and Yacht Street;
- (vi) Morrison Hill Road northbound;
- (vii) Hennessy Road east of Marsh Road;
- (viii) Tin Hau Temple Road between Fortress Hill Road and Causeway Road; and
- (ix) Causeway Road.

### (3) Traffic Arrangements in the Peak Area

#### A. Road Closure

The following road sections will be closed from 4.00 pm to 11.59 pm daily on 17 and 18 September 2024:

- (i) Peak Road northbound outside Peak Galleria will be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for access by local residents or vehicles with permits). All vehicles will be diverted via the slip road next to the carpark entrance of the Peak Galleria to Peak Road southbound; and
- (ii) Lugard Road, Harlech Road, Barker Road and Mount Austin Road will be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for access by local residents or vehicles with permits).

#### B. Suspension of Parking Spaces

All metered parking spaces and motorcycle parking spaces on Mount Austin Road outside Victoria Peak Garden will be suspended from 12.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 11.59 pm on 18 September 2024.

(4) Traffic Arrangements outside Lower Peak Tram Station

A. Road Closure and Traffic Diversion

Tramway Lane outside Lower Peak Tram Station leading from Garden Road to World Wild Fund for Nature will be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for franchised buses) from 8.00 am to 11.59 pm daily on 17 and 18 September 2024.

B. Suspension of Parking Spaces

All metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces and designated parking spaces for people with disabilities on Tramway Lane will be suspended from 00.01 am on 17 September 2024 to 11.59 pm on 18 September 2024.

C. Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand on Tramway Lane outside Lower Peak Tram Station will be suspended from 8.00 am to 11.59 pm daily on 17 and 18 September 2024.

(5) Traffic Arrangements for the Fire Dragon Dances in Aberdeen and Pok Fu Lam

A. Road Closure

(i) The section of the right lane of Nam Ning Street between Hoi Chun Court and Hoi Lung Court, Aberdeen Centre will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 7.00 pm to 9.00 pm on 17 September 2024.

(ii) Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, the following roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic from 4.00 pm to 10.00 pm on 17 September 2024:

(a) Tung Sing Road;

- (b) Wu Nam Street;
  - (c) Lok Yeung Street;
  - (d) Aberdeen Main Road;
  - (e) Aberdeen Old Main Street;
  - (f) Sai On Street;
  - (g) Chengtu Road; and
  - (h) Nam Ning Street.
- (iii) Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, the following roads in Pok Fu Lam and Wah Fu will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic from 4.00 pm to 11.59 pm on 17 September 2024:

- (a) Pok Fu Lam Road near Pok Fu Lam Village (except fast lane);
- (b) Chi Fu Road near Pok Fu Lam Village;
- (c) Chi Fu Road Flyover;
- (d) Wah Fu Road; and
- (e) Waterfall Bay Road.

B. Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand on Nam Ning Street outside Nam Ning Street Sitting-out Area will be suspended from 4.00 pm to 10.00 pm on 17 September 2024.

C. Suspension of Public Light Bus Stand

The public light bus stand on Tung Sing Road between Sai On Street and Wu Pak Street will be suspended from 6.00 pm to 10.00 pm on 17 September 2024.

(6) Traffic Arrangements in Repulse Bay

A. Traffic Arrangements

Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, the following traffic arrangements may be implemented on 17 and 18 September 2024:

- (i) South Bay Road southbound south of South Bay Path may be closed

- to all vehicular traffic, when the carparks on South Bay Road are full (except for access by local residents and public transport service);
- (ii) All vehicles on Beach Road may be diverted onto South Bay Road northbound for leaving the area, when the carparks on South Bay Road are full (except for access by local residents);
  - (iii) All vehicles on Repulse Bay Road eastbound may be prohibited from making an 'U' turn at its junction with South Bay Road; and
  - (iv) All vehicles on Repulse Bay Road may be banned from waiting outside the carpark of The Repulse Bay, if it is full.

B. Suspension of Parking Spaces

All metered parking spaces and motorcycle parking spaces on Beach Road and Island Road (except designated parking spaces for people with disabilities on Island Road) will be suspended from 4.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 6.00 am on 18 September 2024.

C. Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand on Repulse Bay Road opposite to The Repulse Bay will be suspended from 4.00 pm on 17 September 2024 to 6.00 am on 18 September 2024.

(7) Traffic Arrangements in Shek O

A. Road Closure

Depending on the crowd and traffic condition, the following roads may be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for access by local residents and public transport services) on 17 and 18 September 2024:

- (i) Shek O Headland Road; and
- (ii) Access roads to the carparks in Shek O and Big Wave Bay (when the carparks are full).

B. Suspension of Parking Spaces

16 parking spaces at Shek O Beach public carpark will be suspended from 12.00 noon on 17 September 2024 to 8.00 pm on 18 September 2024.



## New Territories

### (1) Traffic Arrangements in Tuen Mun

#### A. Road Closure

The following roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic from 5.00 pm to 5.00 am of the following day daily on 17 and 18 September 2024 (except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by the police on site):

- (i) Golden Beach Path;
- (ii) The unnamed access road leading to the public car park at Cafeteria Old Beach;
- (iii) Tsing Yan Street between Castle Peak Road and the entrance of the public car park at Kadoorie Beach; and
- (iv) The unnamed access road leading to the public car park at Butterfly Beach.

#### B. Traffic Arrangement

Public light buses will be temporarily permitted to enter Tuen Mun Road between Tuen Hing Road and Siu Lam Interchange from 5.00 pm to 5.00 am of the following day daily on 17 and 18 September 2024.

### (2) Traffic Arrangements in Tsuen Wan

#### A. Road Closure

- (i) Tai Mo Shan Road east of its junction with Route Twisk will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 5.00 pm to 3.00 am of the following day daily on 17 and 18 September 2024 (except for access by local residents and emergency vehicles); and
- (ii) The section of Shing Mun Road between Pineapple Dam and the Main Dam will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 5.00 pm to 3.00 am of the following day daily on 17 and 18 September 2024.

#### B. Suspension of Carparks and Parking Spaces

Tai Mo Shan Country Park Carpark will be closed from 5.00 pm to 3.00 am of the following day daily on 17 and 18 September 2024. 23 metered parking spaces and other parking space in the carpark will be suspended during the above period.

(3) Traffic Arrangements in Ma On Shan

A. Road Closure

### **III. Attention and Appeal**

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. Notices will also be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the above temporary public transport arrangements. Adjustment of the above road closures and traffic diversions, or other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversions, alterations and suspension of public transport services, will be implemented by the Police depending on the crowd and traffic condition in the areas.

As road closure and traffic diversion will be implemented at different times in various districts, members of the public are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. In case of traffic congestion, motorists should exercise tolerance and patience, and follow the instructions of the Police. Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precincts of the special traffic arrangements specified above will be towed away or ticketed by the Police without prior notice.

Members of the public who intend to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport services as far as possible, plan their journey early and allow more traveling time to cater for unexpected delay. Bus and green minibus passengers are also advised to pay attention to the route diversions and temporary stop arrangements.

Members of the public are advised to watch out for the latest traffic news through radio and television broadcasts.
