

## **TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE**

### **Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for the Triathlon Event**

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the holding of the Triathlon event, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Central and Wan Chai from 4 to 6 April 2025 (Friday to Sunday):

#### **A. Traffic Arrangements (See Figure)**

##### **I. Road Closure**

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic during the time specified below:

**From 10.00 am on 4 April 2025 to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025**

Expo Drive between Legislative Council Road and Expo Drive Central.

**From 1.00 am to 2.00 pm on 5 April 2025 and from 1.00 am to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025**

- (a) Yiu Sing Street;
- (b) The section of Lung Wo Road eastbound between Man Yiu Street and Fleming Road including the Central-Wanchai Bypass tunnel eastbound slip road from Wan Chai to North Point;
- (c) The section of Lung Wo Road westbound between Lung Tat Path southbound and Tim Wa Avenue southbound;
- (d) Lung Tat Path northbound;
- (e) Lung Hop Street;
- (f) Legislative Council Road between Legislative Council Complex Car Park exit and Lung Wo Road;
- (g) Part of the traffic lane of the slip road of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound heading to Central District;
- (h) Part of the traffic lanes of Man Po Street eastbound near Man Yiu Street;
- (i) Part of the traffic lanes of Man Po Street eastbound near Finance Street;
- (j) Part of the traffic lane of Man Yiu Street southbound between Man Kwong Street and Yiu Sing Street westbound;
- (k) Part of the traffic lane of Man Yiu Street southbound near Lung Wo Road ;
- (l) Part of the traffic lane of Lung Wo Road westbound between Tim Wa Avenue and Man Yiu Street;
- (m) Part of the traffic lane of Fleming Road northbound between Convention Avenue westbound and Lung Wo Road eastbound;
- (n) Part of the traffic lane of Hung Hing Road westbound near Fleming Road;
- (o) The slip road of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound leading to the exit of Lung Wo Road; and
- (p) Part of the traffic lane of Convention Avenue westbound near Fleming Road northbound.

##### **II. Traffic Diversion**

To facilitate the aforementioned road closure arrangements, the following traffic diversions will be implemented:

**From 10.00 am on 4 April 2025 to 12.59 am on 5 April 2025 and 2.01 pm on 5**

**April 2025 to 12.59 am on 6 April 2025**

Affected vehicles on Expo Drive eastbound heading to Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre will be diverted via Lung Wo Road eastbound and Expo Drive East northbound.

**From 1.00 am to 2.00 pm on 5 April 2025 and from 1.00 am to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025**

- (a) Affected vehicles on Man Kwong Street westbound heading to Lung Wo Road eastbound via Man Yiu Street southbound will be diverted via Man Yiu Street southbound, Connaught Place eastbound, Connaught Place southbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound, Harcourt Road eastbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fleming Road northbound;
- (b) Affected vehicles on Man Po Street eastbound heading to Admiralty or Mid-levels via Lung Wo Road eastbound will be diverted via the slip road of Man Po Street eastbound heading to Finance Street westbound, Finance Street westbound, temporary exit connecting Finance Street and Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel, the slip road of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound heading to Man Kat Street eastbound, Man Kat Street eastbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound and Harcourt Road eastbound;
- (c) Affected vehicles on Man Po Street eastbound heading to Lung Wo Road eastbound via Yiu Sing Street eastbound will be diverted via Man Yiu Street southbound, Connaught Place eastbound, Connaught Place southbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound, Harcourt Road eastbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fleming Road northbound;
- (d) Affected vehicles on Man Po Street eastbound heading to Lung Wo Road eastbound will be diverted via Man Yiu Street southbound, Connaught Place eastbound, Connaught Place southbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound, Harcourt Road eastbound, Gloucester Road eastbound, and Fleming Road northbound;
- (e) Vehicles along Man Yiu Street southbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Lung Wo Road eastbound and Yiu Sing Street eastbound. Affected vehicles will be diverted via Man Yiu Street southbound, Connaught Place eastbound, Connaught Place southbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound, Harcourt Road eastbound, Gloucester Road eastbound, and Fleming Road northbound;
- (f) Affected vehicles on Man Cheung Street eastbound heading to Lung Wo Road eastbound will be diverted via Man Yiu Street southbound, Connaught Place eastbound, Connaught Place southbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound, Harcourt Road eastbound and Gloucester Road eastbound and Fleming Road northbound;
- (g) Vehicles along Lung Wo Road westbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Yiu Sing Street northbound. Affected vehicles will be diverted via Lung Wo Road westbound and Man Yiu Street northbound;
- (h) Affected vehicles on Yiu Sing Street eastbound and Yiu Sing Street southbound heading to Lung Wo Road eastbound will be diverted via Man Yiu Street southbound, Connaught Place eastbound, Connaught Place southbound, Connaught Road Central eastbound, Harcourt Road eastbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fleming Road northbound;
- (i) Vehicles along Legislative Council Road northbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Lung Wo Road westbound. Affected vehicles will be diverted via Legislative Council Road southbound, Lung Wui Road eastbound, Fenwick Pier Street eastbound, roundabout, Fenwick Pier Street westbound, flyover, Harcourt Road westbound, Connaught Road Central

- westbound and Connaught Place northbound;
- (j) Affected vehicles on Lung Wo Road westbound heading to Chief Executive's Office via Tim Wa Avenue southbound will be diverted via Lung Tat Path southbound, Convention Avenue, Fenwick Pier Street westbound, flyover, Harcourt Road westbound, Connaught Road Central westbound, u-turn, Connaught Road Central eastbound and Tim Wa Avenue northbound;
  - (k) Vehicles along Lung Wui Road eastbound will be prohibited from turning left on to Lung Hop Street northbound;
  - (l) Vehicles on Fenwick Pier Street westbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Lung Hop Street northbound. Affected vehicles will be diverted via Fenwick Pier Street, flyover, Harcourt Road westbound, Connaught Road Central westbound and Connaught Place northbound;
  - (m) Affected vehicles on Convention Avenue westbound heading to Lung Wo Road westbound via Lung Tat Path northbound, will be diverted via Convention Avenue, Fenwick Pier Street roundabout, Fenwick Pier Street westbound, flyover, Harcourt Road westbound, Connaught Road Central westbound and Connaught Place northbound;
  - (n) Affected vehicles on Expo Drive East southbound heading to Lung Wo Road westbound will be diverted via Lung Tat Path southbound, Convention Avenue, Fenwick Pier Street roundabout, Fenwick Pier Street westbound, flyover, Harcourt Road westbound, Connaught Road Central westbound and Connaught Place northbound;
  - (o) Affected vehicles on Hung Hing Road westbound heading to Lung Wo Road westbound will be diverted to Lung Tat Path southbound, Convention Avenue, Fenwick Pier Street roundabout, Fenwick Pier Street westbound, flyover, Harcourt Road westbound, Connaught Road Central westbound and Connaught Place northbound; and
  - (p) Affected vehicles on Lung Wo Road westbound heading to Central Pier or Finance Street via Yiu Sing Street will be diverted via Lung Wo Road westbound and Man Yiu Street northbound.

## **B. Temporary Bus Service Arrangements**

In connection to the road closure aforementioned, the following temporary bus service arrangements will be implemented during the specified time below:

- (a) XHT Route nos. H1S and H2 (Central (Star Ferry) bound) will be diverted via Fenwick Pier Street, Harcourt Road, Connaught Road Central and Man Yiu Street from the first departure to 2.00 pm on 5 April 2025 and the first departure to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025; and
- (b) The suspension of bus stop on Man Yiu Street near the Two International Finance Centre will be suspended from 1.00 am to 2.00 pm on 5 April 2025 and from 1.00 am to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025.

## **C. Suspension of Metered Parking Spaces and Pick-up/ Drop-off Areas**

The following metered parking spaces and pick-up/ drop-off areas will be temporarily suspended during the time specified below:

**From 10.00 am on 4 April 2025 to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025**

All metered parking spaces and pick-up/ drop-off areas on Expo Drive.

**From 10.00 pm on 4 April 2025 to 2.00 pm on 5 April 2025 and from 10.00 pm on 5 April 2025 to 6.00 pm on 6 April 2025**

- (a) all metered parking spaces on Yiu Sing Street and Lung Hop Street;
- (b) lay-bys on Lung Wo Road westbound near City Hall and near Central Barracks; and
- (c) lay-by on Edinburgh Place near City Hall.

**D. Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles**

Motorists are advised that strict enforcements will be taken by the Police. Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precincts of the special traffic arrangements specified above will be towed away or ticketed by the Police without prior notice.

**E. Attention and Appeals**

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements. Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closures, traffic controls and public transport diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the areas.

The Transport Department anticipates that the traffic in the vicinities of Central district and Wan Chai will be congested. Members of the public who plan to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport services as far as possible. Motorists are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas and should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, follow the instruction given by the Police, and watch out for the latest traffic news through the media.
