

**TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE**  
**Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Drone Show in Tsim Sha Tsui East**  
**on 20 July 2024**

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented to facilitate the Drone Show to be held near Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade in Tsim Sha Tsui East on 20 July 2024:

**A. Special Traffic Arrangements**

**1. Road Closure**

The following roads will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic (except for authorized vehicles) in phases until the crowd is dispersed and the closed roads re-open to traffic:

From 5.30 pm

- (i) Sections of Hung Hom Bypass between Salisbury Road and Hung Lok Road, and between Metropolis Drive and Salisbury Road;
- (ii) Salisbury Road between Cheong Wan Road and Chatham Road South;
- (iii) Salisbury Road underpass;
- (iv) Hong Wan Path;
- (v) Mody Road between Chatham Road South and Science Museum Road;
- (vi) Granville Square;
- (vii) Mody Lane; and
- (viii) Mody Square.

From 6.30 pm

- (i) Chatham Road South southbound between Cameron Road and Salisbury Road;
- (ii) Chatham Road South northbound between Prat Avenue and Salisbury Road;
- (iii) Nathan Road southbound between Kimberly Road and Granville Road;
- (iv) Nathan Road between Granville Road and Salisbury Road;
- (v) Carnarvon Road between Nathan Road and Humphreys Avenue;
- (vi) Kowloon Park Drive southbound between Canton Road and Salisbury Road;
- (vii) Salisbury Road eastbound between Kowloon Park Drive and Chatham Road South;
- (viii) Salisbury Road westbound between Star Ferry Bus Terminus and Chatham Road South;
- (ix) Hanoi Road;
- (x) Bristol Avenue;
- (xi) Mody Road;
- (xii) Blenheim Road;
- (xiii) Minden Avenue;
- (xiv) Minden Row;

- (xv) Haiphong Road;
- (xvi) Lock Road
- (xvii) Hankow Road;
- (xviii) Ashley Road;
- (xix) Ichang Street;
- (xx) Peking Road between Kowloon Park Drive and Nathan Road; and
- (xxi) Middle Road.

## 2. **Traffic Diversions**

In connection with the aforementioned road closure arrangements, the following traffic diversions will be implemented in phases until the crowd is dispersed and the closed roads re-open to traffic:-

### From 5.30 pm

- (i) Vehicles on Hung Hom Road southbound will be directed to the roundabout at Cheong Tung Road South via Hung Hom Bypass;
- (ii) Vehicles on Metropolis Drive eastbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Hung Hom Bypass southbound;
- (iii) Vehicles on Hung Hom Bypass southbound will be diverted to turn right onto Metropolis Drive westbound;
- (iv) Vehicles on Salisbury Road southbound near Hong Chong Road will be directed to Tsim Sha Tsui East;
- (v) Vehicles on Science Museum Road will be prohibited from entering Mody Road;
- (vi) Vehicles on Chatham Road South southbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Mody Road eastbound;
- (vii) Vehicles on Chatham Road South southbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Salisbury Road eastbound;
- (viii) Vehicles on Mody Road eastbound will be diverted to turn left onto Chatham Road South northbound;
- (ix) Vehicles on Salisbury Road eastbound will be diverted to turn left onto Chatham Road South northbound; and
- (x) Granville Road between Science Museum Road and Chatham Road South will be re-routed to one-way eastbound.

### From 6.30 pm

- (i) Franchised buses and green minibuses (GMBs) on Chatham Road South southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Granville Road eastbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Chatham Road South southbound will be diverted to turn right onto Cameron Road;
- (iii) Vehicles on Nathan Road southbound will be diverted to turn left onto Kimberley Road;
- (iv) Vehicles on Granville Road westbound will be diverted to turn right onto Nathan

- Road northbound;
- (v) Vehicles on Canton Road southbound will be prohibited from entering Kowloon Park Drive southbound;
  - (vi) Vehicles on Canton Road southbound will be prohibited from entering Haiphong Road;
  - (vii) Vehicles on Salisbury Road eastbound will be diverted to turn left onto Kowloon Park Drive northbound; and
  - (viii) Vehicles on Kowloon Park Drive northbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Peking Road.

### **3. Suspension of Bus Termini**

The following bus termini will be suspended in phases until the re-opening of roads:

- (i) From 5.30 pm  
Tsim Sha Tsui East (Mody Road) Bus Terminus
- (ii) From 6.30 pm  
Star Ferry Bus Terminus

### **4. Suspension of Parking Spaces and Pick-up/ drop-off points**

All on-street parking spaces along the closed roads in Tsim Sha Tsui (including motorcycle and disabled parking spaces) will be suspended from 12.00 noon to 11.00 pm.

The non-franchised bus pick-up/ drop-off points on Salisbury Road westbound opposite to Wing On Plaza will be suspended from 3.30 pm until the re-opening of roads.

### **5. Suspension of Taxi Stands and Pick-up/drop-off points**

The taxi stands and taxi pick-up/ drop-off points along the closed roads in Tsim Sha Tsui will be suspended during road closure periods until the re-opening of roads.

### **6. Suspension of Public Light Bus Stand**

The public light bus stands along the closed roads in Tsim Sha Tsui will be suspended during road closure periods until the re-opening of roads.

### **7. Suspension of Landing Steps**

- (i) Tsim Sha Tsui Landing Step Nos. 1, 2 and 5 will be suspended from 2.00 pm until

the re-opening of roads.

## 8. Restrictions on Access to/ exit from Carparks

Vehicles parked in all carparks within the closed road area in Tsim Sha Tsui will not be permitted to enter or leave the carparks from about 5.30 pm until the re-opening of road sections. Motorists wishing to park their vehicles in these carparks are advised to do so before the road closures and shall prepare to accept that their vehicles cannot leave the carparks until the uplifting of the road closures.

## B. Public Transport Arrangements

### 1. MTR Service

For MTR services, Island Line, Tsuen Wan Line, Tuen Ma Line, East Rail Line and Tung Chung Line will be strengthened subject to passenger demand on 20 July 2024.

### 2. Franchised Bus Services

#### (i) Bus Diversions and Bus Stop Arrangements

In connection with the road closures in Tsim Sha Tsui, the following bus diversions and temporary bus stop arrangements will be implemented from about 5.30 pm until the re-opening of roads. The bus stops along the closed road sections, the section of Canton Road between Kowloon Park Drive and Salisbury Road and the section of Kowloon Park Drive northbound between Canton Road and Salisbury Road will be temporarily suspended during the road closure periods.

**3. Green Minibus Services**

In connection with the temporary road closures and traffic diversions, the following GMB routes will be temporarily diverted from about 5.30 pm until the re-opening of roads. The GMB stops along the closed road sections, the section of Canton Road between Kowloon Park Drive and Salisbury Road and the section of Kowloon Park Drive northbound between Canton Road and Salisbury Road will be temporarily suspended during the road closure periods.

#### **4. Ferry Services**

In connection with the Drone Show to be held in Tsim Sha Tsui East, the short-working Route of “Water Taxi” will be temporarily suspended from 12.30 pm to 7.05 pm on 20 July 2024.

#### **C. Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles**

Motorists are advised that strict enforcement will be taken by the Police. Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precincts of the special traffic arrangements mentioned above will be towed away or ticketed by the Police without prior notice.

#### **D. Attention and Appeal**

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. Notices will also be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the above temporary public transport arrangements. Adjustment of the above road closures and traffic diversions, or other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversions, alterations and suspension of public transport services, will be implemented by the Police depending on the crowd and traffic condition.

Due to road closure in the affected areas, the Transport Department anticipates that the traffic in the vicinities of Tsim Sha Tsui will become significantly congested.

Members of the public who intend to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport services as far as possible, plan their journey early and allow more traveling time to cater for unexpected delay. Bus and green minibus passengers are also advised to pay attention to the route diversions and temporary stop arrangements.

Members of the public are advised to watch out for the latest traffic news through radio and television broadcasts.
