TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Yau Ma Tei

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate Central Kowloon Route construction, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Yau Ma Tei from 10.00 am on 7 June 2024 to 31 August 2024: -

(A) <u>Traffic Arrangements</u>

(I) Road Closure

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:-

- (i) The section of Kansu Street between Battery Street and Ferry Street; and
- (ii) The section of Battery Street between Kansu Street and Reclamation Street.

(II) <u>Traffic Direction Conversion</u>

The section of Saigon Street between Canton Road and Ferry Street will be temporarily converted into one-way westbound.

(III) Banning of Turning Movement

- (i) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making left turn movement from Ferry Street southbound into Saigon Street;
- (ii) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making right turn movement from Ferry Street northbound into Saigon Street; and
- (iii) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making left turn movement from Canton Road northbound into Kansu Street.

(IV) Prohibited Zones for Vehicles

- (i) Reclamation Street between Battery Street and Kansu Street will be temporarily designated as prohibited zone for vehicles exceeding 8 metres in length 24 hours daily; and
- (ii) Kansu Street between Shanghai Street and Battery Street will be temporarily designated as prohibited zone for vehicles exceeding 12 metres in length 24 hours daily.

(V) Traffic Diversions

- (i) Affected vehicles on Kansu Street heading for Tsim Sha Tsui will be temporarily diverted via Kansu Street westbound, Battery Street southbound, Saigon Street westbound and Ferry Street southbound;
- (ii) Affected vehicles on Kansu Street heading for Mong Kok and Kwai Chung will be temporarily diverted via Kansu Street westbound, Battery Street southbound, Saigon Street westbound and Ferry Street northbound;
- (iii) Affected vehicles exceeding 12 metres in length on Shanghai Street heading for Mong Kok and Kwai Chung will be temporarily diverted via Shanghai Street southbound, Jordan Road westbound, Hoi Wang Road northbound, Yan Cheung Road eastbound and Ferry Street northbound;
- (iv) Affected vehicles exceeding 12 metres in length on Shanghai Street heading for Hong Kong (West) will be temporarily diverted via Shanghai Street southbound, Jordan Road westbound and Lin Cheung Road northbound;
- (v) Affected vehicles exceeding 12 metres in length on Kansu Street heading for Mong Kok and Kwai Chung will be temporarily diverted via Shanghai Street southbound, Jordan Road westbound, Hoi Wang Road northbound, Yan Cheung Road eastbound and Ferry Street northbound; and
- (vi) Affected vehicles exceeding 12 metres in length on Kansu Street heading for Hong Kong (West) will be temporarily diverted via Shanghai Street southbound, Jordan Road westbound and Lin Cheung Road northbound;
- (vii) Affected vehicles on Ferry Street southbound heading for Saigon Street will be diverted via Jordon Road eastbound and Canton Road northbound;
- (viii) Affected vehicles on Ferry Street northbound heading for Saigon Street will be diverted via Yan Cheung Road westbound, Hoi Wang Road southbound, Jordon Road eastbound and Canton Road northbound;
- (ix) Affected vehicles on Canton Road northbound and Kansu Street westbound heading for Ferry Street will be diverted via Saigon Street westbound; and
- (x) Affected vehicles on Man Cheong Street eastbound heading for

Saigon Street will be diverted via Ferry Street southbound, Jordan Road eastbound and Canton Road northbound.

(B) Transport Arrangements

I. Bus Diversions

- (i) KMB route no. 36X (Tsuen Wan (Lei Muk Shue) bound) will be temporarily diverted via Shanghai Street southbound, Jordan Road westbound, Wui Man Road southbound, Wui Cheung Road eastbound, Canton Road northbound, Ferry Street northbound and Yan Cheung Road eastbound before resuming its original routeing; and
- (ii) KMB route nos. 280X (Fo Tan (Sui Wo Court) bound) will be temporarily diverted via Shanghai Street southbound and Jordan Road westbound before resuming its original routeing.

II. Bus Stop Arrangement

The existing bus stop of KMB route no. 280X on Yan Cheung Road westbound will be temporarily relocated to Shanghai Street southbound near Saigon Street.

III. Green Minibus (GMB) Diversions

- (i) Kowloon GMB Route No. 43M (Tai Kok Tsui bound) will be temporarily diverted via Battery Street southbound, Saigon Street westbound and Ferry Street northbound before resuming its original routeing;
- (ii) GMB Route No. 3 (Tai Kok Tsui bound) will be temporarily diverted via Jordon Road eastbound and Canton Road northbound before resuming to the original routeing;
- (iii) GMB Route No. 26 (To Kwa Wan bound) and Route No. 26X (Hung Hom bound) will be temporarily diverted via Jordan Road eastbound before resuming to the original routeings; and
- (iv) GMB Route No. 74 (Mong Kok bound) and Route No. 74S (Ho Man Tin bound) will be diverted via Man Wai Street westbound, Man Cheong Street northbound, Man Cheong Street eastbound, Ferry Street southbound, Jordon Road eastbound and Canton Road northbound before resuming to the original routeings.

IV. Green Minibus (GMB) Stop Arrangements

- (i) The existing GMB Stop of Route No. 43M on Kansu Street will be temporarily relocated to Battery Street outside Yau Ma Tei Market;
- (ii) The existing stop of GMB Route No. 3 on Ferry Street near Man Ying Building will be temporarily relocated to No. 511 Canton Road northbound near Jordan Road; and
- (iii) The existing stop of GMB Route No. 26 and 26X on Ferry Street near Man Ying Building will be temporarily suspended.

Appropriate traffic signs and road markings will be erected on site to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
