

Details of road closures and traffic arrangements

1. From 2am on June 29 to 2pm on July 1, there will be implementation of closure of roads in the vicinity of the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre, Wan Chai North (including Expo Drive, Expo Drive East, Expo Drive Central, Lung Wo Road, Lung King Street, Lung Hop Street, Fleming Road, Convention Avenue, slip roads leading from the Central – Wan Chai Bypass (CWB) Tunnel to Wan Chai North/Fenwick Pier Street roundabout and slip road leading from Lung Wo Road eastbound to the CWB Tunnel etc.) will be implemented.
2. From 0.01am on June 30 to 11.59pm on July 1, the following road sections in Wan Chai will be temporarily designated as restricted zones throughout the time period:
  - (i) the southern kerbside lane of Gloucester Road service road between Tonnochy Road and Fenwick Street;
  - (ii) the eastern kerbside lane of Stewart Road between Gloucester Road service road and Jaffe Road;
  - (iii) the western kerbside lane of Tonnochy Road between Gloucester Road service road and Jaffe Road; and
  - (iv) the southern kerbside lane of Lockhart Road near Lockhart Road Municipal Services Building.
3. Most of the on-street parking spaces in Wan Chai (such as Jaffe Road) will be suspended, and vehicles in car parks within the road closure areas may not be permitted to enter or leave the car parks during the road closure period. Motorists are advised to avoid driving to the affected or congested areas, especially in the vicinity of Wan Chai, unless necessary. In case of road closure and traffic diversion, motorists should follow the instructions of the Police on site and the guidance of road signs, and stay alert to the latest traffic news through the media.
4. In connection with the temporary closure of Edinburgh Place between Lung Wo Road and Connaught Road Central starting from 0.01am on June 30, the City Hall Car Park situated at 1 Edinburgh Place, Central will be closed until road closure is lifted. Motorists are reminded to drive their vehicles away from the car park by 7pm on June 30 at the latest. After that, those vehicles which remain parked in the car park may be towed away by Police.

## Annex 2

### Details of public transport arrangements

1. The bus terminus at Expo Drive East will be suspended until 2pm on July 1 and the Exhibition Centre Station Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 2am on June 29 to 2pm on July 1. For the 23 bus routes terminating at Wan Chai North, of which eight bus routes will be truncated, two bus routes will be converted to circular service, one bus route will be relocated to Admiralty Station (West) Bus Terminus, three bus routes will be relocated to Admiralty Station (East) Bus Terminus, and one bus route will be relocated to Moreton Terrace Bus Terminus and the remaining eight bus routes will be diverted to operate from Gloucester Road service road and Hennessy Road. The TD will upload the detailed temporary public transport arrangements to its website ([www.td.gov.hk](http://www.td.gov.hk)) and mobile application “HKeMobility”;
2. The Exhibition Centre Station of East Rail Line will be temporarily closed from 1am on June 30 to 2pm on July 1, while the Exhibition Centre Station Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 2am on June 29 to 2pm on July 1. East Rail Line trains will not stop at Exhibition Centre Station from the first departure on June 30 until the reopening of the station;
3. The taxi stands at Expo Drive, Harbour Road, Lung Wui Road westbound outside CITIC Tower and Exhibition Centre Station Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 10pm on June 28 to 2pm on July 1; and
4. The green minibus stand on Johnston Road eastbound outside Methodist House will be suspended from 1am on June 29 to 11.59pm on July 1.
