## Anonymous Elder Octopus and ordinary Personalised Octopus are not covered under \$2 Scheme

- From 25 August 2024, eligible beneficiaries must use either JoyYou Card<sup>1</sup> or Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status"<sup>2</sup> to enjoy the \$2 Scheme. Hong Kong residents aged 60 or above (including eligible persons with disabilities), and those reaching the age of 60 in three months, can submit application for JoyYou Card. Each eligible applicant will be issued with one JoyYou Card only.

<sup>1</sup> JoyYou Card is applicable to Hong Kong residents (including eligible persons with disabilities) aged 60 or above

<sup>2</sup> Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" is applicable to eligible persons with disabilities aged below 60

- There is an expiry date for the "Persons with Disabilities Status" encoded on the Personalised Octopus of eligible persons with disabilities. Eligible persons with disabilities aged 60 or above have no need to apply for renewal of the "Persons with Disabilities Status" after switching to a JoyYou Card.

- Eligible persons with disabilities aged below 60 can continue to enjoy the \$2 Scheme using the Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status".

Card replacement is not required.

## How to apply for a JoyYou Card



Via Octopus App

or

By posting the application form

Applicants should send the completed application form with a copy of their Hong Kong identity card and a 1.5 x 2 inch colour passport photo (with white or plain light colour background) taken within six months by post to the address specified on the application form. JoyYou Card will be mailed to the correspondence address in Hong Kong given by eligible applicants within four weeks upon receipt of the required information and documents.

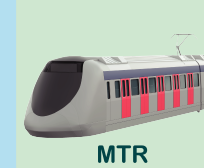

## Application Fee

- The HKSAR Government subsidises the administrative fee for the first application of eligible beneficiaries.
- No activation of JoyYou Card is required. It can be used after topping up with an amount higher than HK\$50 via Octopus add-value channels. The initial top-up amount will include a refundable deposit of HK\$50.

## Public Transport Modes and Services under \$2 Scheme



MTR

Domestic MTR services, including Light Rail and MTR Bus (Northwest New Territories)

(Excluding the Airport Express, East Rail Line services to and from Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau and Racecourse Stations, and first-class service of East Rail Line)



Franchised Buses

Franchised bus routes of Kowloon Motor Bus, Citybus, Long Win Bus and New Lantao Bus

(Excluding "A" and "NA" routes to the airport, racecourse routes, new long-haul services and the routes on a pre-booking and group hire basis)



Ferries

Designated ferry services

(Excluding deluxe class services)



Green minibuses

All green minibuses routes



Red minibuses

Designated services of red minibuses and kaitos approved by the Transport Department to join the \$2 Scheme
