- (iv) incident management within the tunnel area viz. vehicle recovery and rescue and cleansing work;
- (b) operation and maintenance of the electrical and mechanical equipment and electronic systems of the tunnel, including:
 - (i) power supply system;
 - (ii) tunnel lighting system;
 - (iii) ventilation system (including the Air purification system); and
 - (iv) traffic control and surveillance system; and
- (c) providing non-structural maintenance and repairing works for proper upkeep of the tunnel.

The duration of the agreement shall be four (4) years commencing on a date the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region shall specify by notice.
